Have you been waiting for the right live aboard trawler to come along—one that's ready to fulfill your dreams of a lifetime? One that is safe, sturdy, seaworthy—large enough to handle the open seas—handy and able enough to sneak into secure snug anchorages—with room to spread out, with spaces to stow all your favorite stuff?



Maybe it's time to take a closer look at the Great Harbour 37!

When it comes to the **Absolute Best Liveaboard in the World**, there is only one candidate—the **Great Harbour 37**, the **most liveable trawler in her class!** She fulfills the bill for the serious cruising couple who want to cruise *and* spend a lot of time on board.

- **Master Stateroom** with 8' feet of hanging locker, island queen, 10 drawers and 8 additional lockers.
- **Big Head** (two on version B) with large roomy shower and fresh-water toilet..
- **Roomy and Efficient Galley.** The Vers B comes standard with a 22 cu.ft. refrigerator/freezer with ice & water in the door. Both versions come standard with 250 VAC digital flat glass, four burner, radiant cooktop and a combination microwave/convection oven. Solid countertops with matching sink are also standard.
- **Versatile 2nd Stateroom.** The Vers A has a full sized desk and settee & Pullman berths. The Vers B has its own head with stall shower and a settee berth; optional overhead cabinets & bookcase can be installed. Most guests will use this space as a changing room, choosing to sleep in the extra-long double berth in the pilot house. Both versions have under berth drawers & hanging lockers.
- **Spacious Saloon** opening onto the covered aft cockpit. The Version A has a settee to port with end cabinet and bookcase; the sideboard/entertainment center is to starboard. There is an



optional hi/low dining table available for the Vers A. The Vers B has a desk/dining table/entertainment center to port with a breakfast bar opening to the galley. Settee is to starboard; the dining table pulls out from the desk. The standard, over/under washer/dryer is to starboard in both versions.

- **Pilot House.** Both versions share the same great pilot house. There are chart flats surrounding the helm; the center console folds out for access to the electronics wiring. The raised settee converts to an extra-long double berth and there is a full-time pilot berth aft. Great storage is under the berth and consoles. The only pilot house around with full all-around visibility!
- **Engine Room.** The GH37 comes with a pair of Yanmar 56 HP diesels standard. There is plenty of space to access all systems and for the optional 8 kW generator.
- **Storage.** Any true liveaboard boat needs plenty of storage — there is generous dry storage in two bilge alleyways under the accommodation sole. Outside, there are a pair of seat lockers on the foredeck, a pair on the bridge deck, another pair on the boat deck and 2 lockers in the aft cockpit for a total of 8 deck lockers. Under the cockpit sole is a roomy lazarette. There is an optional transom seat/locker available for the cockpit.



It is the attention to the needs of the liveaboard couple that make the Great Harbour such a fine vessel for full-time living!

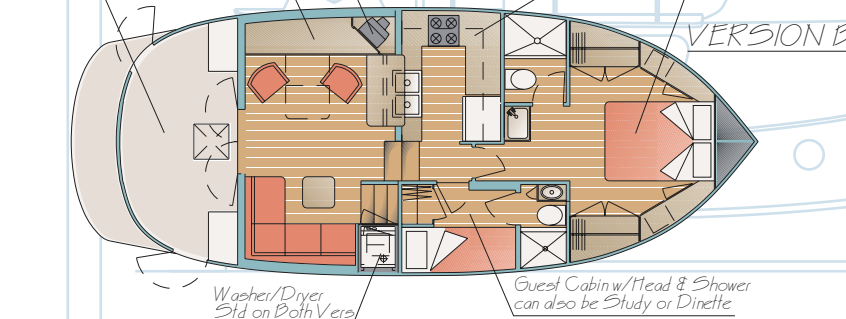
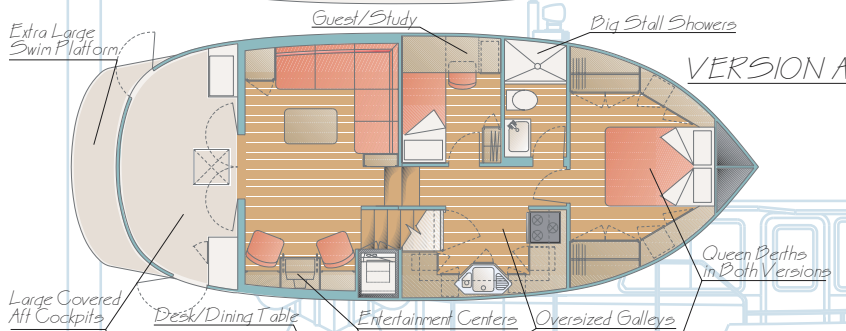
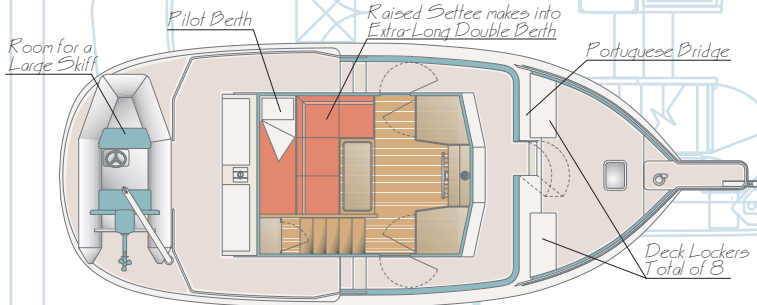
